Feeling Earth - A Ceramic Workshop for Seeing Hands

Target Age group: late teens and adults with vision impairment

This workshop is a feast for the senses. Participants will be introduced to various types of ceramic media from adobe to terracotta and paper clays. Exploration of textures and earthen scents of these clays is of great importance. The students will also be introduced to examples of fired clays and ceramic pieces to explain the creative and technical process. Again, emphasis is placed on tactile exploration of clay surfaces and various types of glazes.

The tutor will then guide the group through a number of creative exercises with clay. Enveloped and inspired by music, participants will shape their own abstract clay sculptures and enrich the tactile quality of their work by incorporating gravel, pebbles, sticks, fibre, straw, nails and other non-clay materials. Students will have the opportunity to take their work home to experience the textural changes in the material as it dries and hardens.
