### **Draft Tweed Local Environmental Plan 2010 27 January 2010 – 31 March 2010**

Council resolved on 27 January 2009 to publicly exhibit the Draft Tweed Local Environmental Plan 2010.

In accordance with Clause 12 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Regulation 2000*, and Section 66 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*, notice is hereby given of the exhibition of draft Tweed Local Environmental Plan 2010. The purpose of the draft LEP is to provide planning controls in accordance with and to implement the State Governments planning reforms through the *Standard Instrument (Local Environmental Plans) Order 2006*, for the Tweed Shire.

The draft Plan will be available for inspection from **Wednesday 27 January 2010 to Wednesday 31 March 2010** at the following places:

- Murwillumbah Civic Centre from 8.00am to 4.30pm weekdays;
- Tweed Heads Civic Centre from 8.00am to 4.30pm weekdays;
- Kingscliff Library from 10.00am to 5.00pm Tuesdays, Thursdays & Fridays, from 10.00am to 7.00pm Wednesdays, and from 9.00am to 12 noon Saturdays.
