Fact Sheet 4 - Submissions



How do I lodge a submission about the Draft Tweed LEP 2010 and/or Draft Tweed City Centre LEP 2009?

Council strongly recommends all residents and community groups review the LEP in relation to their particular property or area of interest. This is your opportunity to check how the LEP relates to your land and tell Council what you think.

Submissions to either Draft LEP should be made in writing to Council and received before the closing of the submission period on 31 March 2010.

For individuals lodging a submission, there should be a clear indication of the relevant property details that the submission relates to, including where possible, the street address and title (Lot and DP) details. It should also clearly articulate specific aspects of the LEP that are being addressed within the content of the submission.

For community groups lodging submissions, Council encourages a clearly articulated account of the matters or areas in issue.

Submissions to each plan must be made separately to either Draft Tweed LEP 2010 (Shirewide) or Draft Tweed City Centre LEP 2009.

All submissions will be considered and addressed in the final drafting and reporting of the Draft Tweed LEP 2010 (Shirewide) and Draft Tweed City Centre LEP 2009 to Council. It is also noted that submissions may be publicly inspected, excluding the individual author's name and address.
