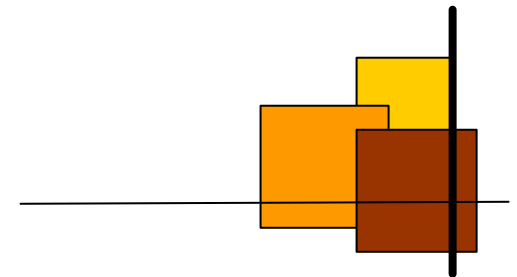

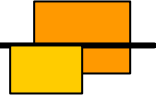

As part of the *Tweed Shire City of the Arts 2003 – 2005 Cultural Program*, The City of the Arts Space, in Murwillumbah, will host a dynamic series of Professional Development Workshops over the next twelve months.

The *City of the Arts Space Professional Development Workshop Program* aims to maximise and improve the economic viability of the Tweed's growing creative and arts-based industries.

The twelve-month program will comprise two focus areas:

**1. Industry Practice** – The highly competitive environment in which regional artists and volunteer organisations now operate means that there is a real need to implement a range of effective organisational, management and marketing strategies. The workshops series will provide insights into industry practice and will include:

- Business Planning and Management
- Marketing & Promotion
- Funding and Resources
- Developing and Managing a Budget
- Tendering for Expressions of Interest
- Project Management

**2. Creative Practice** - This workshop program is designed to complement and support specific projects currently being developed under the umbrella of the City of the Arts. This dynamic program will comprise workshops and training in:

- Writing an Oral History
- Script Development
- Directing for the Screen
- Storyboarding and Camera technique
- Physical Theatre, Drama & Dance
- Museums Practice

The City of the Arts Space Professional Development Workshop Program will be of particular interest and value to the Shire's many volunteer and cultural organisations. Festival and event organisers, theatre companies, museum workers, commercial and community gallery operators, practicing artists and students studying in the creative industries field will all benefit from the workshops.

These are the first workshops in the series.

### **\*Creative Volunteering Workshops For Arts Workers & Community Organisations**

The Creative Volunteering Workshop series has been organised in collaboration with Arts Northern Rivers. The series presents a wonderful opportunity for artists and community organisations to develop the skills and networks that will ensure long-term success.

You can come to all the workshops or those you find relevant, and will have the opportunity to work on issues your organisation is grappling with now. You will receive training packages and resource booklets, and get a nationally recognised Statement of Attainment. Feedback from workshops throughout Australia has been very positive.

The workshops, which will be facilitated by Media and Promotions professional, Nikki Fuda & will cover issues of survival, including FUNDRAISING, MARKETING and BUSINESS PLANNING and have been especially designed for both staff and volunteers from community organisations where volunteers do much or all of the work. Organisations are encouraged to pay for their volunteers to attend.
