RE- USE OF CIVIC CENTRE.

The Club,s President, Mr. Peter McLaughlin has informed me that he has booked the Civic Centre once again for our High Schools Workshop on Tuesday, 9<sup>th</sup>. September, 08

To enable me to finalise this arrangement I would appreciate your consideration of a request for a reduction in the usual rental to School rates for the following reasons –

- A. The Jazz Club is a non profit registered association and has since its inception 12 years ago directed a large proportion of its small profit plus sponsors contributions into the education of students through various workshops.
- B. These workshops have been conducted by leading masters of Jazz in Australia and in recent years have been directed by Prof. John Hoffman. This type of tuition would normally only be available in Capital Cities or conservatoriums so the cultural benefit to local students is very important.
- C. Our club does not charge students or members for these workshops and the total cost of production is provided from our funds.
- D. The club currently supports 4 sections of the Murwillumbah Festival of performing Arts in the Jazz Arts ( Individual Vocal and Instrumental and bands under 16 years and 20 years. The winners of these sections will perform at Greenhills on Tweed on the last Friday of July and August where they will receive Perpetual Trophies ,Individual Trophies, and Cash Prizes totaling \$600.

You will be aware that Council has very generously granted our club \$2000 towards the cost of production of our abovementioned student education programmes. However any reduction in cost would be greatly appreciated.

Dear Mike,

As President of the Tweed Banana Festival, I would like to request the use of the Civic Center Auditorium under similar terms as previous festivals, with the council donating the use of the auditorium on the specified dates at no fee as part of council sponsorship of the event.

We would also ask that again the council meet the cost of acquiring and erecting the catwalk for the Fashion parade as was the case last year.

The dates the auditorium is required are Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> August through to and including Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> August.

All evening functions, being on 22<sup>nd</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> August, will be concluded by midnight and the Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> family fun day will conclude by 8pm, we also have discussed street closure for the family fun day within your relevant departments and the Murwillumbah police.

We seek permission to use the public park area adjacent to the Memorial as part of our family fun activity's and subject to the completion and hand over to council of the new three leveled car park.

We seek permission to use this area also for Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> August only, from 9am – 8pm.

Wharf street retailers will have access to the rear of their premises until 12 noon via traffic control officers.

We have reviewed the itinerary for the festival; the family fun day on the 30<sup>th</sup> is instead of the Friday night street carnival.
