

PBNC's digital mentors guide people over the age of 50 who do not engage with digital technology to thrive in a digital world through its Get Smart Seniors (GSS) training activity. It's simple to make your first appointment with PBNC to start your learning plan.

Services offered: PBNC specialises in assisting seniors with all their technological needs. The Technology Centre has modern computers running Windows 10.

- Casual internet and computer access.
- IT tutoring by trained digital mentors in how to use computers, smart phones and tablets. All sessions individually tailored and based on learner needs.

 Advocating in relation to contracts, plans and pitfalls of telecommunications.

Bookings: Appointments are essential for one-on-one tutoring.

Costs:

- Casual internet and computer access
 \$1 for every 15 minutes or \$4 per hour.
- One on one tuition \$5 for a 1 hour tutoring session.

Services offered: TACT Computer Club instructs people in the use of Windowsbased operating systems. Lessons run for approximately 1 hour.

Classes range from absolute tech beginners, use of email and internet, photo management – through to more advanced instruction using the current Microsoft Office programs. The club has 10 Windows computers.

Classes are also held for android tablets and phones, iPads and iPhones. Students bring own tablets and phones for these courses.

Cost: For students to attend the computer club they are required to become financial members of the South Tweed Sports Club (\$5 for 3 years).

Computer Club membership: \$15 for the first year.

Each lesson attended costs \$5. Booking: required.
