

# **2022 FLOODS**

### Help if you've been affected by storms and floods.

Disaster assistance is avaliable to help **Tweed Shire Council** communities recover from recent flooding. For support, phone **13 77 88**.



#### **Disaster Assistance**

The **Disaster Relief Grant** helps people recover from a disaster and restore a basic standard of living.

You may be eligible for financial support if:

- your home (primary place of residence) was damaged by a natural disaster
- you do not have insurance for the damage
- you are a low-income earner with limited financial resources
- it has been less than four (4) months since the disaster

Visit a Recovery Centre and ask for help with your application. Bring proof of your income; proof of your assets such as three months of recent bank statements; information about your home loan repayments or rent; and, if insured, information from your insurer.

Phone 13 77 88 and ask about the "Disaster Relief Grant" administered by Resilience NSW



The **Disaster Recovery Payment** is a one-off, non-means tested payment from the Australian Government. For this disaster, the payment and a special supplement will offer \$3,000 to adults and \$1,200 for each affected child.

You may be eligible if:

- you have been seriously injured
- have lost or had your home damaged

The **Disaster Recovery Allowance** provides short-term income support payment from the Australian Government to assist individuals whose income has been affected as a direct result of the storms and floods, for up to 13 weeks.
