Description of the works	Exterior painting of the store
Painting has been done to a high standard and consistent with the heritage of the General Store. This has enlivened the streetscape of the Tyalgum Conservation Area. The General Store signage is also to be replaced at a later stage.



Grant paid	\$4,242
Total cost of improvements	\$11,990
Description of the works	Exterior painting
The quality cleaning, treating and high standard of painting of the buildings will provide protection of the painted surfaces. The maintenance of the building reinforces its heritage significance within the streetscape.

Uki Hall, Kyogle Road Uki

Grant paid	\$1,758
Total cost of improvements	\$3,516
Description of the works	Replacement of guttering to the front of the hall, termite treatment, weather proof hoods to external rear doors, replacement of glazing to front windows
The works undertaken will halt further deterioration of the hall through the replacement of the guttering, weather protection of the doorways and windows and termite treatments. The replacement of the inappropriate coloured glass improves the appearance of the front of the hall and brings the facade back towards its original styling, improving its heritage significance within the streetscape.

Lisnagar House, Kynnumboon

Grant paid	\$5,000
Total cost of improvements	\$10,470.92
Description of the works	Repair and reinstate the balcony rails, deck and iron fretwork

Lisnagar is a significant part of the Tweed settlement and has remained in the ownership of the Twohill family since it was built. In recent year the maintenance of the house has declined and the grant has provided a valuable avenue to commence restoration works of the outer verandahs, which had deteriorated. The works have respected the heritage significance of the building and have brought the ground level up to a standard that will be easier to maintain and protect.

Total cost of conservation management plan	\$4,807
Description of the works	Preparation of a Conservation Management Plan for the Uki Butter Churn

The Uki Historical Society (UHS) now have a comprehensive management plan for the short, medium and long term conservation of the butter churn. This provides a maintenance framework and will enable the UHS to plan for future maintenance and apply for further grants to undertake this work.
