

## Procurement standards

### Sustainable procurement product list

PRODUCT	MINIMUM REQUIREMENT
Tap fittings (internal and external)	4 star Water Efficiency Labeling Scheme (WELS) rating.
Toilets	4 star WELS rating.
Urinals (trough and wall hung)	5 star WELS rating (preferably waterless – with maintenance flush if required).
Washing machines (clothes)	4 star WELS rating. 4.5 star energy rating.
Clothes dryers	3.5 star energy rating.
Washing machines (dishes)	4 star WELS rating. 3.5 star energy rating.
Fridges and Freezers	3.5 star energy rating.
Showerheads	3 star WELS rating.
Printers, copiers, faxes, scanners, computers, monitors, televisions, DVD players, etc .	ENERGY STAR® compliant – where a rating exists, appliances must be a minimum of 3.5 star energy rated.
Hot water urns	Timer switch to be included in the install.
Hot water systems	Minimum 4 star energy rating and incorporating solar or heat pump technology wherever possible.
Split system air conditioners	Minimum 5 star energy rating. Consider the use of solar or heat pump assisted units.
Packaged unit air conditioners	Minimum 5 star energy rating. Consider the use of solar or heat pump assisted units.
Other energy/water consuming equipment	For all other energy and/or water consuming products ensure the product is in the top 5 for efficiency.
Office paper	Minimum 50% recycled content and Forestry Stewardship Council certified.
Toilet paper/hand-towels	Not to be sourced from native forests. Preferably with post-consumer recycled paper content.
