

Energise – lower your power bills Free Energy Saving Home Assessments

Competition terms and conditions

Prize

Receive a tailored home energy consultation from a Residential Efficiency Scorecard accredited assessor, including energy bill analysis, onsite consultation, follow up contact and analysis of outcomes. Prize winners will receive tailored recommendations including technology, behaviour change, and low cost DIY options.

The competition is open to all individuals who attend the 'Energise – lower your power bills' events on Wednesday 8 February and Friday 10 February as part of Seniors Festival 2023, except employees or contractors of Tweed Shire Council or their immediate family members and any person otherwise connected with the organisation.. Previous recipients of free Home Energy Assessments from previous Tweed Shire Council competitions are ineligible to enter again.
