A8. Applicants Declaration

Competent Person Details – A competent person for building work, means a person who is assessed by the building certifier for the work as competent to practice in an aspect of the building and specification design, of the building work because of the individual's skill, experience and qualifications in the aspect. The competent person must also be registered or licensed under a law applying in the State to practice the aspect. If no relevant law requires the individual to be licensed or registered to be able to give help, the certifier must assess the individual as having appropriate experience, qualifications or skills to be able to give the help. If any guidelines are available for assessing a competent person, the building certifier must use the guidelines when assessing the person.
