### Taking care of our environment

Planted 5000 trees for koala habitat and 800 trees to improve Tweed River water quality; National Threatened Species Day Free talk; Ran community toad busting initiatives.

Completed 60 roadworks projects with 13 underway; Reopened 1 lane at Scenic Drive landslip; Awarded tender for Reserve Ck Rd landslip; Determined 204 Das - 261 received; Promoted National Asbestos Awareness Month

### Inclusive, active and vibrant communities and economy

Celebrated International Day of Disability; Opened new inclusive playground at Fingal Foreshore Park; Began construction of new mountain bike track near Uki; Installed Christmas decorations across the Tweed; Announced Wollumbin Art Award winners; Capturing Nature exhibition (Tweed Regional Museum); Launched 4 new exhibitions at Tweed Regional Gallery; Sponsored 6 local events.

### Working together to reduce our impact

Introduced balloon ban to reduce destructive impact on marine life; Launched Climate Ready Tweed Griffith University partnership; Held Tweed Eco Festival; Began Stotts Creek Resource Recovery Centre upgrade; Hosted Second Hand Saturday to reduce waste; Participated in National Recycling Week.

### Building resilience to natural disasters and climate change impacts and delivering sustainable water and wastewater services

Launched new flash flood alert system; Secured funding for new pump station to reduce flood impacts; Launched flood monitoring cameras; Donated to Community Rescue Helicopter; Conducted tender for re-establishment of Tweed Heads SES

### Joining together to be better tomorrow

Distributed over \$80,000 from Mayoral Flood Appeal; Elected Cr Meredith Dennis as new Deputy Mayor; 25 items open for public comment; 7,209 registered users of Your Say Tweed (2% increase); Council endorsed Growth Management and Housing Strategy Issues Paper following extensive community consultation.

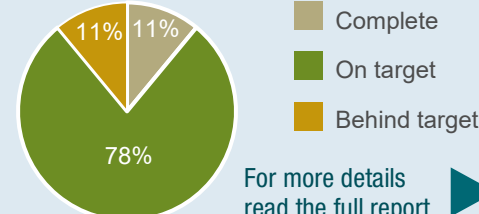
